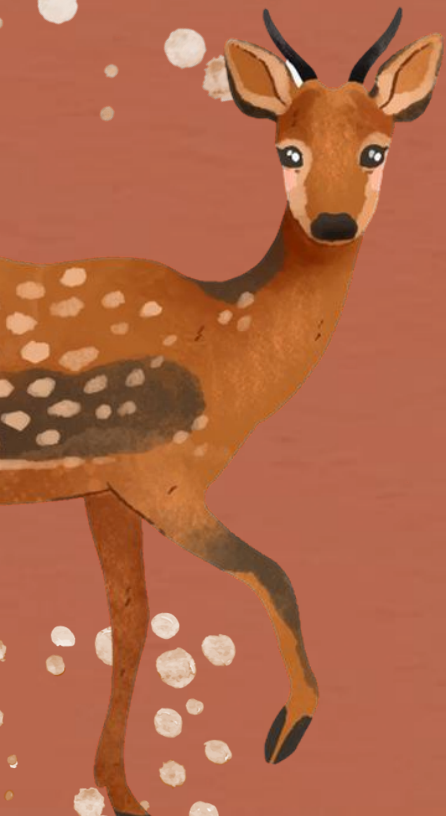

Our school is located in the middle of the village Buruienesti.



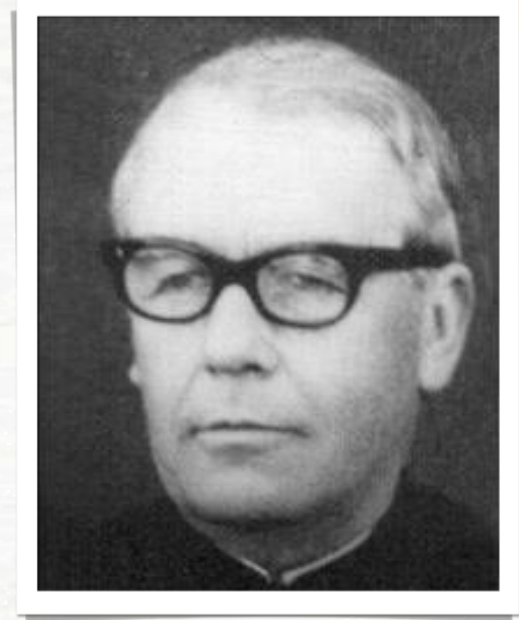


This is our beautiful school! 



Who was Gheorghe Patrascu?

Gheorghe Patrascu was born on the 30th of September 1913 in Buruienesti. He became a priest on 4th of April 1937. Gheorghe spent his first years of priesthood being a teacher. In Buruienesti he was considered "son of the village". He died in Bucharest in 1995.



The history of our school

by the authorities for the
children in Buruienesti. Since
2002, our school was named
“Gheorghe Patrascu” School
in the memory of the priest.

Some of our schoolmates love acting, so our teachers help them achieve this skill. They even participated in an Intercounty Theatre Festival and won prizes.

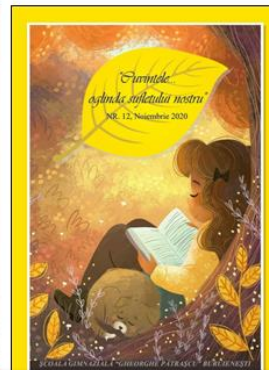
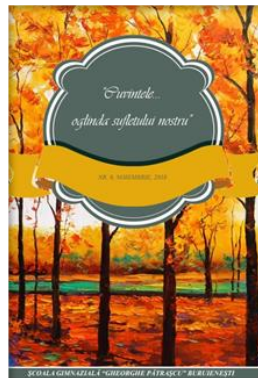
We sometimes organize puppet theatre for our younger students.





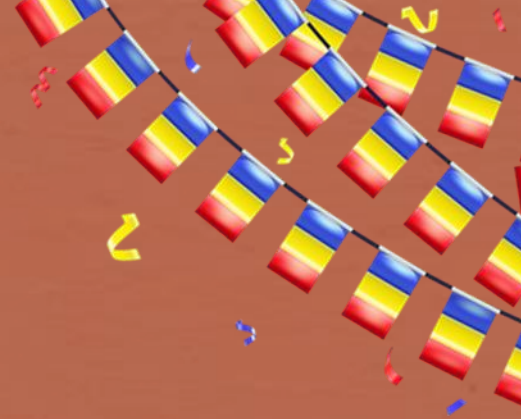
School magazine

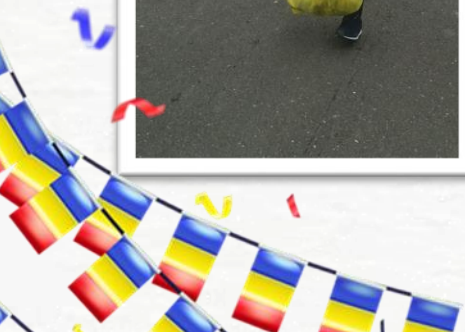


The Green Week

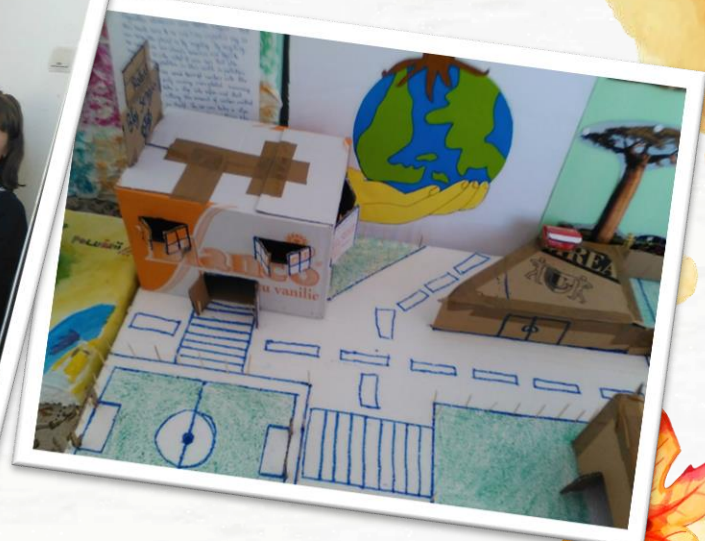
During the "Green Week" we do different activities for the environment and we learn things about nature and climate change for a better community.



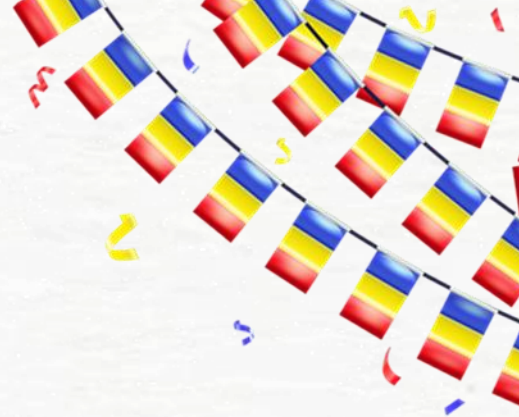
Community clean up
