During the first LTTA in Spain (25 -29 April 2023) the students learned and discussed the project related subjects such as the effects of climate change on the agriculture in each country. They had prepared presentations about the subject during the local activities. The students also gave presentations about some aspects of their culture, their home countries, hometowns and schools and thus learned from each other about the common European citizenship. The participants learned about the specific features of Andalucian nature and its conservation by visiting some phenomenal examples of it. Both students and teachers gained useful knowledge about solar energy and its possibilities when visiting Plataforma solar del Almeria that is the largest research, developing and test centre of solar energy in Europe.



During the teachers' meetings the teachers went through Step 1 of the project to make sure that everything has been done or to be done during the local activities. The partners also checked the present stage of the eBook and agreed on the next activities that will be prepared for it during Step 2. The preparations for the LTTA2 in Istanbul were started.
