

Before the second LTTA in Türkiye (02-06 October 2023) the participating students were given specific roles to make research on to be able work on their roles as forest experts, oceans experts, frozen zone experts, grasslands experts, freshwater experts and world leaders in the 'World summit' arranged on the final day of the LTTA. During the week the students worked in international groups to prepare for the summit.
